JOB SPOTLIGHT

OVERVIEW

Our Job Spotlight videos are short, narrated clips that highlight various jobs, focusing on the skills required, the best and worst aspects of the job, and interesting facts. Accompanying the videos are Job Spotlight booklets, which offer a printable summary of each job and a word search featuring key terms. These resources help children to pre-read about upcoming jobs or recap information from previous videos. See below our 'Recommended Order of Teaching' to gain an overview of what order to use this resource.

USAGE

There are six Job Spotlight videos for each term, so we suggest showing a new one every couple of weeks. We advise printing the Job Spotlight booklets before you show the first video of the school year.

GUESS MY JOB ACTIVITY

OVERVIEW

The 'Guess My Job' activity involves video-led sessions where children use clues and their current knowledge of different careers to guess a mystery job. Each video includes an interview with someone about their job, with children using a bingo sheet to help identify the job. This activity reinforces learning from across the entire MYPATH resource catalogue.

USAGE

There are six Guess My Job videos for each term, so we suggest showing a new one every couple of weeks. We recommend alternating a Job Spotlight video with a Guess My Job activity each week to ensure careers education is included every week. Worksheets are differentiated for Lower KS2 and Upper KS2, allowing all KS2 classes to participate simultaneously. This activity works particularly well when all KS2 classes participate at the same time, fostering discussion and engagement across the school.





WHY BOTHER?

OVERVIEW

The "Why Bother?" resource introduces three different jobs related to upcoming lessons. This has the potential to make learning more purposeful for children by showing real-life job applications.

USAGE

This resource is designed to be played when moving on to a new piece of learning in maths, science, or English. There is a video for each new topic mentioned by the National Curriculum. These videos are perfect for KS2 students and help them understand the relevance of their lessons to real-world careers.

SKILLS SESSIONS

OVERVIEW

Our Skills Sessions are selfguided, video-led lessons designed to teach various skills. These sessions are particularly useful in addressing stereotypes from an early age, which research shows can impact future aspirations.

USAGE

Each session is divided into three parts, with each part lasting 25-40 minutes (depending on the year group). These sessions can be spread out over the year or combined for a special careers afternoon, such as during Careers Week in early March. The resource pack includes everything needed for the session: PowerPoints, lesson plans, and handouts, all ready for immediate use.
